Nurse Case Managers, in consultation with the patient's physician, are responsible for all aspects of care and comfort.

Home Health Aides are available to help patients with the activities of daily living.

Insurance Covers Most Services

Much to the surprise of many families and patients, hospice care is covered by Medicare, Medicaid and most insurance companies. Patients pay nothing for OKPHC services if they meet Medicare's hospice benefit guidelines. To qualify, patients must: (1) have an irreversible illness, (2) have chosen not to aggressively fight the illness and (3) their physician recommends them for care.

We provide your day-to-day care under the guidance of our medical director, but we also work closely with your referring physician to get valuable guidance and keep him/her informed about you, as well as any emerging conditions.
